

1-Day Pistol Red Dot Critical Precision Course

Tactical Options Pistol Red Dot Sight Critical Precision Course is a 10-hour basic to intermediate level of performance program designed to advance the individual's knowledge on pistol fundamentals with a mounted RDS system, motor skills, and speed under a series of progressive teaching stages and drills. Pistol RDS systems are, and have been, evolving as a more common primary pistol sight system within the shooting community. It is important to advance on confidence of applying the RDS system with the correct fundamentals for full achievement of precision shot placement in small hit variables.

Students will receive critical skills and knowledge through comprehensive building blocks of instructions and performance on a mounted pistol RDS. Therefore, shortcutting trials and errors of impractical and / or incorrect teaching methodologies and performance stages that may limit or hurt the student being trained on the application of a mounted RDS system. These concepts are crucial in training students on care and maintenance of Pistol RDS systems, efficient economy of motion techniques for sight acquisition and sight tracking during stress courses of fire, enhanced pistol fundamental application, and increased everyday readiness status. This program will prepare the student on accountability on applying their shot, tactics, and drills that focus on sustainability of critical skillsets.

This 1-day program and course objectives includes:

- Every day mental readiness, individual weapon and kit maintenance and preparation, kit / duty set up (principle vs shooter's solution)
- RDS familiarization on technology, mounting, cleaning and care, and optics adjustment buttons, weather and lighting considerations
- Enhanced RDS fundamental application and principle training path at various distances
- RDS precision shot accuracy drills that focus on grouping advancing to limited angle shots, HR shot requirements and low-percentage shot drills, active shooter precision shooting drills
- Sight tracking methods during presentation and cadence fire at various distances
- Target assessment and shot placement under stress at various distances and stages
- Multi-target engagement at various target formations, depths, and angles
- Mechanics and efficient economy of motion of pistol speed reload and tac-mag reloads with threat follow through while maintaining accountability of pistol RDS
- Pistol manipulation techniques on a with pistol with and pistol mounted RDS on malfunction clearance procedures combined with recovery for rapid target engagement
- Failed pistol mounted RDS to iron sight transition, sight acquisition, and precision target engagement

- Moving and shooting / shooting while moving at different angels and depths: RDS sight tracking
- Barricade occupation during threat engagements, clearance procedures, and pistol sight clearance awareness when breaking plains of cover or clearing unknown sectors
- Speed and accuracy drills requiring combinations of movement, cover barricade usage, shoot / no-shoot targets, stress on performance of fundamentals and individual's assessment and execution
- Tactical shooting drills that advance skills for confined spacing and close quarters environments
- Various body positions stressing pistol manipulation and shot accuracy
- Critical Task Evaluations speed and accuracy standards and execution
